Class sessions to resume for Confirmation 2, First Communion students at I.C.

After a long coronavirus delay, Immaculate Conception is back on track with sacramental preparations for First Communion, First Reconciliation and Confirmation.

Completion of classwork is the first goal. There will be Sunday morning classes for Sacramental Prep, First Communion and second-year Confirmation on July 26, August 2 and August 9. Attendance is mandatory.

The First Reconciliation classes taught by Kathy Norwood and Dulce Ruiz will prepare with one class on Sunday, August 9, at 10:30.

All classes will run 90-minutes, from 10:30 until 12 noon. Teachers included are Kim Jones, Reyna Burgos and David Jones. Students in other grades will come back to class when the fall semester begins.

We are hopeful – with God’s grace and no Covid-19 delays – to have the conferral of First Communion and Confirmation in late August or early September. There will also be a mini-retreat on a Saturday (to be announced) for confessions and spiritual formation.

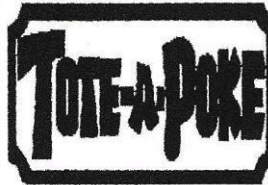
